Items Accepted: Aerosols, auto liquids, cleaners, corrosives, fertilizers, glue, herbicides, medicines, oil-based paints, pesticides, and solvents. (**Marked with CAUTION, CORROSIVE, DANGER, FLAMMABLE, POISON, REACTIVE, TOXIC AND WARNING**)

We will **NOT ACCEPT**: explosives, bombs, fireworks, smoke alarms, smoke detectors, propane tanks, or building materials of any kind. *Call 275-3163 for specific handling of these items.*

Special Collections

(Please keep these items separate from the hazardous waste)

NEW ITEM: Clean Styrofoam containers, plates, cups - no peanuts, must be clean

Batteries (all types)

Cell phones (no regular phones allowed)

Computers

Ink Jet Cartridges (**not Laser or fax roller cartridges**)

PAINTS of ALL TYPES (GOOD, usable and container must be at least 1/2 full, NO RUSTY CANS!)

Televisions

Tires (on or off rims) up to 4 per household free, \$2.00 each tire after that
