RESOLUTIONS

1. Move to adopt the “Resolution to Authorize a Declaration of a State of Emergency for the County of Roscommon”:

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE COUNTY OF ROSCOMMON

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2020, the County of Roscommon sustained one of the first confirmed cases of COVID-19 within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, any widespread outbreak within the County of Roscommon could hinder and/or cease most daily operations within the entire County and overwhelm Emergency Services, Urgent Care Clinics and School Districts; and

WHEREAS, the County of Roscommon is currently experiencing an increase in positivity ratings for COVID-19 and wishes to ensure that any and all resources available are utilized to combat potential exposures; and

WHEREAS, the Roscommon County Board of Commissioners believes that it is necessary to authorize a Declaration of a State of Emergency for Roscommon County through May 1, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Roscommon County Board of Commissioners, in accordance with Section 10 of 1976 PA 390, as amended, hereby declares that a State of Emergency exists within our jurisdiction as of March 21, 2020, and that local funding and resources are being utilized to the fullest possible extent. Any local response and recovery elements of our emergency operations plan have been initialized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED. That this Declaration replaces any other Declarations and will expire on May 1, 2021.
