Special Meeting Minutes *February 22, 2021*

The Roscommon County Planning Commission met on Monday, February 22, 2021 via ZOOM

Chairman Julie Crick called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Barb Stauffer made motion to approve agenda, second by David Russo, motion carried.

Reports

Barb Stauffer made motion to approve minutes of 11 January, 2021, second by David Russo, motion carried.

Unfinished Business – None

Correspondence – The Roscommon County Planning Commission received a copy of the Denton Township zoning ordinance amendments for Marihuana Facilities and Accessory Buildings. Rachael Barnes presented the amendments on behalf of Denton Township.

For the first amendment regarding Marihuana Facilities: Rachael stated that nothing has changed regarding where in the County the facilities will be located. Wording has been changed to reflect that an application for the two Marihuana facility licenses available “*can be for supplying Medical Marihuana or Recreational Marihuana.*” The previous licensing only provided for Medical Marihuana provisioning facilities.

For the second amendment regarding Accessory Buildings: Rachael stated that the amendment proposed fixed an error in the last amendment to give all districts the right to request a Special Use Permit from the Planning Commission for a *third accessory building if under five acres*. Previously the amendment stated “accessory building size requirements on parcels five acres or larger.”

After discussion, Kirstie Russo made the motion to concur with the zoning ordinance amendments presented by Denton Township. Julie Crick second, motion carried.

New Business – None

For the Good of the RCPC – David Russo stated that at the last Commissioner’s meeting the Roscommon County Planning Commission was discussed. The board of Commissioners feels that the County Planning Commission gives them insight and a feel for what is going on in the community. At that meeting the County Clerk stated that the by-laws for the County Planning Commission need to be updated. Julie Crick stated that she has a copy of the current by-laws and she will be sending them to the members of the board for review.
